

GENERAL RULES

ARTICLE 1

PURPOSE OF THE REGULATION

The present regulation of the Angelini University Award! 2020/2021, hereinafter referred to as Regulation, has the aim to define the access and functioning of the 3rd edition of the Angelini University Award, hereinafter referred to as "AUA!20/21" or shortly as "Contest".

ARTICLE 2

PROMOTING ENTITY

The competition is organized by Angelini İlaç San. ve Tic. A.Ş., registered office: Nispetiye Mah. Aytar Cad. Fecri Ebcioğlu Sk. RSD Plaza No:4 Kat:1 34340 Beşiktaş / İstanbul (hereinafter referred to as "Angelini Pharma").

ARTICLE 3

PURPOSE OF THE CONTEST

The Contest aims to bring dynamism to the innovation and creativity scene in the areas of knowledge that are related to Health subjects, through the distinction of a project recognized by the jury for its quality and relevance.

ARTICLE 4

RULES ABOUT THE PRIZES ATTRIBUTION

1. Angelini Pharma reserves the exclusive right to interpret and apply the rules set forth herein and to resolve any issues not dealt with by these rules.
2. The selection criteria and the reasons for the decision, including prize award, are the sole decision-making authority and responsibility of Angelini Pharma. Under no circumstances, any complaint or appeal against the evaluation of this competition, which is irreversible and definitive, cannot be lodged.
3. Angelini Pharma reserves the right not to award a prize if such a step were inconsistent with the applicable rules, or if the jury finds that none of the submitted projects meets the rules of the competition, for example, it does not achieve the required quality.
4. Angelini Pharma reserves the right not to award prizes if less than 10 projects sign up for the competition, or less than 10 projects are submitted within the specified deadline.

ARTICLE 5

SCOPE OF PROJECTS

The scope of the “AUA!20/21” is Health of Healthcare Professionals - Projects & Approaches. University students are invited to propose projects in the strands that relate to this topic.

In this context, approaches from economic, humanistic, financial, creative and technological natures may apply, particularly those in the following fields of knowledge: Medicine, Pharmacy, Nursing, Social Service, Social Entrepreneurship and Development, Psychology and Sociology, Economics and Management. Below are some suggestions of themes for project that may be undertaken under the scope of the Contest:

- To develop contemporary solutions that will facilitate the work of healthcare professionals,
- Projects that will increase the motivation of healthcare professionals,
- Projects produced to reduce the physical, biological and chemical risks faced by healthcare professionals,
- The impact of healthcare professionals’ problems on society;
- To increase the efficiency of healthcare professionals' relations with the society
- Solutions to protect healthcare professionals against possible dangers
- Projects on relations between healthcare professionals and patient relatives
- Technological solutions to increase the quality of life of healthcare professionals
- Protective equipment for healthcare professionals
- Social support groups for healthcare professionals
- Protecting the health of healthcare professionals and good nutrition
- Reducing the emotional burden of healthcare professionals
- Projects on the prevention of occupational burnout of healthcare professionals
- Training of healthcare professionals on social issues

PARTICIPANTS

ARTICLE 6

SCHEDULE

- 1.The Competition will take place from 25th of May 2021 to 30th of May 2022.
 - 2.The application must be submitted no later than 1st of March 2022, 23:59.
 - 3.The deadline for submitting projects is 1st of March 2022, 23:59.
 - 4.The public voting will take place in April 2022.
 - 5.The final ceremony will take place in May 2022.
- Competitors will be notified in advance if there is a change in the specified dates.*

ARTICLE 7

PRIZES

1. Prizes are of a monetary nature; a specific amount of money will be rewarded to two of the best projects:
 - a) The first group shall receive 25.000 TL gross (if this complies with the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 8)
 - b) The second group shall receive 15,000 TL gross (if this complies with the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 8)

- 2.The distribution of the awards among the individual team members shall be made equally by Angelini Pharma. Each member of the winning team receives an honorary certificate valuing their work.
- 3.The winners understand that the prizes are subject to statutory income tax and in accordance with the law, the prizes will be duly taxed by the Angelini Pharma of the competition prior to handover,
- 4.All contestants / Competition Team or authors of the other projects and their individual members receive a certificate valuing their participation in the competition.
- 5.The entitlement to the award of prizes will automatically and definitively disappear without any further formal procedure, if one of the following situations arises:
The winning team/team's application contains discrepancies; There are indications that the project concerned has been drawn up by persons other than those indicated in the application.

- a) If there is any deficiency in the application of the award winners;
 - b) If the project has been developed by others not mentioned in the application submitted.
 - c) The winner does not apply for the payment of the prize within one year from the date of its award,
 - d) The winner/winners refuse to express unconditional approval of these rules,
 - e) The project topic does not correspond to the given topic or otherwise violates the rules of this competition or morality.
6. Unless otherwise provided by the provisions of these Rules, the allocation of prizes shall not, in addition to obtaining a monetary reward, confer other rights. In this Regulation, awarding of award shall not entitle any other rights except to allocate the related amount.

ARTICLE 8

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Participants in this competition may only be teams consisting of 2 – 5 individuals who are university students within the framework of bachelor's, master's and postgraduate study programs in the academic year 2020/21 at a university in Turkey, including students studying within exchange programs (hereinafter referred to as

- "Competition Team", "Participant" or "Contestant").
2. The Competition Team must select one of their members to act as their representative (hereinafter referred to as "Team Leader"). Each individual member of the Competition Team must be able to prove that he/she is a student of the relevant university by submitting the relevant documents proving the above to the competitor's invitation. The competition projects must meet the following requirements:
- a) The competition projects fully apply to the rules of this competition and meet the quality requirements of the competition, Each Competition Team may enter this competition in the academic year 2020/2021 only once,
 - b) Their author must not be a member/member of the jury,
 - c) Each individual member of a team may be a member of only one team or one participant,
 - d) Members of the Competition Team may and may not study at the same university or at the same course,
 - e) Each team consist of a minimum of two and a maximum of five members,
3. The winning projects can only be awarded once.

ARTICLE 9

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. Applications that meet the requirements of this Regulation must be filled in the application form on the www.aua.com.tr website until the relevant deadline.
2. Formalization of the application means that the candidates accept this Regulation unconditionally and unconditionally and give clear authorization to confirm the accuracy of the information provided.

ARTICLE 10

PROCEDURES FOR PREPARING AND DELIVERING THE PROJECTS

1. The submitted projects to the competition should meet the following criteria, they must contain:
 - a) The name of the project; the identification of the individual authors (members of the Competition Team) of the project and the educational institution where they belong,
 - b) The project may not exceed 50 pages, should be prepared and sent in PPT, PDF or similar editor
 - c) The projects must be written in Turkish or English

2. The PPT presentation can be supplemented with file attachments (posters, video footage, models, models, MP4 or WMA format videos, product samples, etc.).

SELECTION DISCLOSURE AND DELIVERY OF PRIZES

ARTICLE 11

CRITERIA

In the assessment of the projects, the jury will value the merit of the projects through the following parameters:

- Innovation.
- Creativity.
- Methodologies / Techniques.
- The relevance of the project to the subject.
- Practical feasibility of projects / implementation (including compliance with legal regulations).

ARTICLE 12

JURY

1. The jury of the competition consist of members experts in areas covering the topic of the competition and one of them shall be appointed as the chairman of the jury.
2. The jury members will be announced when the time comes.
3. If the jury does not feel competent to assess the substance of a project, they may ask one or more experts to cooperate if most of its members agrees with it. The contact with the expert/experts is provided by the chairman of the jury or a member of the jury appointed by the chairman of the jury.
4. After all the projects have been submitted; the jury evaluates and selects no more than 15 finalists of this competition.

ARTICLE 13

DISCLOSURE AND DELIVERY OF PRIZES

1. AUA!20/21 Awards will find their winners with an event to be held on a pre-announced date.

2. The creators of the top 15 projects will participate in the public voting before presenting their projects, and the 5 projects with the most votes in the public voting will be invited to the event mentioned above. At the end of the presentation, there will be a vote on the best project that can be cast by all (invited) AUA!20/21 participants, which means all participants in the competition being present at the event (except for finalists) as well as other participants.
3. Following the day of the event, Angelini Pharma will publish the winners' names on the website.
4. To qualify for the prize, the participants in the competition whose projects were selected as the winning ones by participants in the AUA!20/21 must meet the following conditions:
 - a) Participate in the event (at least 1 member of the Competition Team).
 - b) The individual members of the Competition Team must agree to publish their personal data (name, surname, city, university) and publish their photographs to the extent specified by these Rules: the publish and use the project to promote the competition.

ARTICLE 14

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY OF PROJECTS

The intellectual property rights related to the project belongs to the project authors. However, individual members of the Competition Team, by their participation in the competition and by signing up for the competition, give the Angelini Pharma a non-exclusive free consent allowing the Angelini Pharma use the projects and all its components solely for the purpose of organizing, evaluating and promoting the competition, in particular at public events and on www.aua.com.tr website, and for promotional and marketing purposes within the Angelini University Award! promotion, to an unlimited extent (including unlimited territory, quantity, and time). The Angelini Pharma is not obliged to use this license and is entitled to modify the projects for their needs in accordance with the Copyright Act, as amended, and to continue to use the modified projects. If for the purposes of the Copyright Act, any necessary further approval of the Participant is required for any further handling of the project (e.g. its modification, processing, translation, the creation of a joint work, etc.); such consent is expressly granted by participating in this competition.

Individual members of the Competition Team explicitly declare that they are the authors/co-authors of the project and are authorized to grant such authorizations. If the competition proves otherwise, the Competition Team member shall be fully responsible for all damages incurred to the Angelini Pharma in this respect and shall be obliged to fully pay for the damages forthwith. In particular, this means that if, due to a lack of the above, the Angelini Pharma or any other person has suffered any damage (e.g. imposing an obligation to provide satisfaction or to impose a fine) or expenses, the relevant member of the Competition Team is obliged to pay them in full.

ARTICLE 15

FINAL DISPOSITIONS

The terms and dates contained in these Regulation may be changed by Angelini Pharma's sole decision, under a specific announcement.
